An Act to amend tobacco control laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Possession of Tobacco Products by Persons Under 18
- 2 M.G.L. Chapter 270. Section 6b
- 3 Section 1. Prohibited
- 4 No person under the age of 18 shall be permitted to possess any tobacco products.
- 5 Section 2. Violations and penalties
- 6 Any person found to be in possession of any tobacco product who is under the age of 18
- 7 shall have the tobacco product seized.
- 8 Any person found to be in possession
