An Act relative to physician health information technology.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. The first paragraph of section 2 of chapter 112 of the General laws as
2 amended by section 108 of chapter 224 of the acts of 2012 is hereby amended by deleting the
3 words “As used in this section, proficiency, at a minimum shall mean that applicants demonstrate
4 the skills to comply with the “meaningful use” requirements, as set forth in 45 C.F.R. Part 170.”
