*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 143 of Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding to the end,
- 2 the following words:—" and to excavation, processing, and processing for re-use of earth products
- 3 for construction purposes located on the same property".
