An Act prohibiting disclosure of service observing information.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 44 of Chapter 166 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
2 official edition is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the follow new paragraph as
3 follows:-

4 “It shall be a prohibitive practice for a telecommunication company conducting service
5 observation to inform a telemarketer or any other person or entity when a telephone customer is
6 using their service.”
