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In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen  
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An Act relative to death benefit claims.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 70 of chapter 111, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word “program” in lines 39,55 and 62, the following  
3 words: “or a death benefit claim filed pursuant to the provisions of chapter 32.”
