An Act relative to restroom accommodations in family restaurants.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after  
2 section 6B the following section:-

3           Section 6C. A person licensed as an innholder or common victualler who operates an  
4 establishment that such license holder publicly holds out or advertises as a food establishment  
5 serving families with children, including without limitation, by offering a menu of food choices  
6 specifically offered or designed for children or advertising or promoting the establishment as one  
7 serving families with children, shall provide at least 1 designated diaper-changing area or facility  
8 on the premises that are open to all patrons.
