An Act to jet ski safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 9B of Chapter 90B of the General Laws as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition
is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence in line 4 and inserting in place thereof the
following sentence:-

All persons who operate a jet ski, surf jet or wetbikes shall be required to participate in a regulated mandatory training program before operating such watercraft; provided, however, that the director of said division shall establish the program criteria and content and shall determine the minimum sofety skills personant for said persons to energies such watercraft.
