An Act relative to elevator inspection fines.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 65 of chapter 143, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following:-

3           The department shall provide notice of expiration of inspection certificate to the owner or  
4 operator at least 90 days prior to expiration. The notice shall include, but not be limited to,  
5 explanation of fines imposed by this section. An owner or operator of an elevator shall not be  
6 issued fines as prescribed by this section unless reasonable notification of expiration was issued  
7 by the department.
