An Act relative to the disclosure of autopsy reports.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 38 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2           Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following paragraph:
- 3           “Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the Office of the Chief Medical
- 4           Examiner from providing a copy of the autopsy report of a decedent to the decedent’s surviving
- 5           spouse or a person in the first of degree consanguinity.”
