An Act pertaining to creditable service for veterans.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section XX. Section 46 of chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after subsection 1B the following subsection:-

3           (1C) An employee with 7 years of creditable service who is a veteran, as defined in the  
4 forty third clause of section 7 of chapter 4, shall upon the employee's seventh anniversary date of  
5 hire be advanced to the maximum step in the employee's job group.

6           Section XX. An employee who, as of the effective date of this act, satisfies the  
7 requirements of subsection 1C of section 46 of chapter 30 of the General Laws shall immediately  
8 be advanced to the maximum step in the employee's job group.
