An Act relative to third party medical providers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any special or general law, or regulation to the contrary, any third party  
2   contactors providing medical oversight to firefighters covered under Chapter 41 section 111F  
3   shall be mandated under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of State to ensure reasonable medical  
4   treatment and care.
