An Act providing for the retirement of all municipal employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Chapter 32 of the General Laws is amended by adding the following:—
- 2           Notwithstanding any general or special laws to the contrary all municipal state employees
- 3 may opt to retire with a superannuation allowance equal to fifty percent of his or her salary, fifty-
- 4 five years of age and twenty-five years of service. It must be accepted by local option
