An Act relative to the definition of Group 4 of the retirement system.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: The definition of Group 4, as set forth in chapter 32, section 3, paragraph  
2 (2), subparagraph (g) is hereby amended by adding thereto the words: employees of the  
3 Commonwealth who are employed as steam fireman/co-generation, third class engineer/co-  
4 generation, second class engineer/co-generation, first class engineer/co-generation and chief  
5 engineer/co-generation.
