An Act relative to residency.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general, special, or regulation to the contrary that: MGL Chapter 31
- 2 Section 58 be amended as follows, in line 33 after the word within by deleting the words "ten
- 3 miles" and adding the words "fifty miles".
