3 Section 1. Chapter 150E, as appearing in the 2000 Official Edition shall be amended in  
4 section 6 by adding after the word “workload”, in line 7, the following:- and in the case of fire  
5 and police, personnel, shift manning levels.

6 Section 2. Said chapter is further amended by adding at the end of section 7(B) the  
7 following: No cost items agreed to and executed by the parties shall be deemed unenforceable  
8 once a negotiated collective bargaining agreement becomes effective by reason of the procedure  
9 set forth herein.
