An Act to further regulate the attendance by police officers at police association executive board meeting.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 100G<sup>1/2</sup> of chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting, after  
2 the words, "while 2 in attendance of meetings of the executive board of the Massachusetts police  
3 association", the following words:--; 3 "or while in attendance of meetings of the executive board  
4 of the International Brotherhood of Police Officers 4 (IBPO)."
