An Act relative to protecting the rights of custodial and other non teaching employees of school districts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 59B of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "chapter", in lines 13 and 14, the  
3 following words:- ;provided, however, that in case of custodial, maintenance and other non-  
4 teaching positions, the hiring, promotion and termination of such employees shall be conducted  
5 in accordance with chapter 31 if such positions are classified as civil service positions or in  
6 accordance with any governing collective bargaining agreement.
