An Act relative to the retirement rights of Massport employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby  
2 amended to include mechanical maintenance men, consisting of plumbers, steam pipe fitters,  
3 facility technicians, building equipment mechanics, building mechanical maintenance man A,  
4 mechanical department foremen and immediate supervisors located at MASSPORT located at  
5 the Logan International Airport located in the City of Boston in Group 2 of the retirement  
6 system.
