*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1:

2           Section one of chapter one hundred fifty E of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
3 adding to the end of the sixth paragraph, titled "Employer" or "public employer", the following  
4 sentence:— In the case of employees of the committee for public counsel services, employer  
5 shall mean the committee for public counsel services or its designee.
