An Act relative to the officers of the court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 58 of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "custody", in line 19, the  
3 following words:- , or in the case of a court officer, receives bodily injuries resulting from acts of  
4 violence in the courtroom or public areas, holding areas and other designated areas of the  
5 courthouse or from subduing or apprehending escaping prisoners.
