An Act relative to the retirement rights of police officers in human service facilities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3(g) of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby  
2 amended to include all police officers at health and human service facilities in Group 4 of the  
3 retirement system.

4           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
