An Act relative to indemnification.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 100 of Chapter 41, of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the words “members of the fire alarm division”
- 3 after the words “fire fighter” throughout the section.
