An Act relative to indemnification.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 41, Section 100B of the General Laws, as appearing in the Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking the words “majority of the members” in line 19 and  
3 inserting the word “member” and by striking the word “and” in line 23 and inserting the word  
4 “or” and by striking the words “within six months” in line 31.
