The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act to update the home improvement contractor law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1- There shall be a special commission to study the feasibility of updating the
laws regarding regulation of home improvement contractors. The commission shall investigate
the effectiveness of the Residential Contractor's Guaranty Fund and the feasibility of improving
the civil action system and enforcement of civil judgments.

5 The Commission shall consist of the Attorney General or their designee, the Sheriff of

6 each county or their designee, a representative of the Chief Justice of the District Court from

7 each county, the Chief Justice of the Boston Municipal Court or their designee, the

8 Undersecretary of Consumer Affairs and Business Regulation or their designee, a representative

9 of the Massachusetts Consumers' Coalition, a representative of the Associated Builders and

10 Contractors of Massachusetts. The commission shall convene its first official meeting not later

11 than one year from the passage of this Act. The commission shall issue their report not later than

12 one year after the first official meeting. The commissioners shall not receive compensation.
