*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1: Section 6 of Chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “insulin”, in line 171, the  
3 following: , any materials or devices used in the monitoring of diabetes, including, but not  
4 limited to, blood glucose monitoring strips.
