An Act relative to the film tax credit percentage.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 6 of Chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 edition, is hereby amended in line 516 by inserting after the words “year” the following:-  
3 “;provided further, that 10 per cent of the said 25 per cent shall not be credited unless the motion  
4 picture production company’s total aggregate payroll is composed of at least 50 per cent  
5 Massachusetts residents”.
