An Act relative to the taxation of cellular telephones.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting the following new section:
- 3 (x) Allowances afforded to a purchaser in a bundled cellular telephone transaction, so-4 called. For the purposes of this subsection, allowances exempt from taxation shall be the difference between the amount the dealer charges for a particular telephone in a bundled
- 5
- 6 transaction and the price the dealer would charge for that same telephone in an unbundled
