An Act relative to liquor stores.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1            Clause (52) of section 6 of chapter 136 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “day”, in line 169, the following  
3 words:- ; provided, however that any such retail establishment located in any city or town in  
4 Essex county, Middlesex county or Worcester county, which city or town is located within 10  
5 miles of the New Hampshire border; provided further, that no such sale shall occur unless such  
6 permit has been granted; and, provided further, that such permit shall not allow such sale to  
7 occur prior to the hour of 10:00 A.M.
