**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**

An Act the fair share pension act.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (b1/2) of subdivision (1) of section 22 of chapter 32 of the  
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line  
3 99 after the word “dollars.” the following:- For any member of any system accepting the  
4 provisions of this paragraph who entered the service of the commonwealth or a political  
5 subdivision thereof on or after January 1, 2013, the treasurer or other disbursing officer in charge  
6 of payroll in any governmental unit to which a system pertains, shall withhold on each pay day,  
7 in addition to the amounts withheld pursuant to paragraph (b), and the amount withheld pursuant  
8 to the preceding sentence, an additional 28 per cent of such member’s regular compensation over  
9 \$100,000.
