*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 44B, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting, following the words "Standards for Rehabilitation", the following words:-  
3 "and Standards for Reconstruction".

4           Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
