An Act making municipalities eligible to attend auctions for the purchase of motor vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

3 Section 57A. Any person or company engaged in the business of conducting auctions for  
4 the sale of motor vehicles shall allow any agent acting on behalf of a municipality to attend said  
5 auctions and purchase motor vehicles.
