An Act to encourage affordable housing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 2	Chapter 44B of the General Laws as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition is hereby amended by adding the following new section:-
3	Chapter 44B: Section 10 ¹ / ₂ . Linkage Programs; Neighborhood Housing Trusts.
4	Section 10 $\frac{1}{2}$. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 53 of chapter 44 of the
5	General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, a city or town which has
6	adopted a linkage program and has established a neighborhood housing trust under Chapter 371
7	of the Acts of 1987 shall be eligible to receive monies from the community preservation trust
8	fund established under section 9 of chapter 44B of the General Laws.
9	(b) The commissioner of revenue shall disburse money into a city's neighborhood
10	housing trust according to the provisions of section 10 of chapter 44B. The amount of money to
11	be disbursed shall be equal to the amount collected by a city in affordable housing exactions
12	under chapter 371 of the acts of 1987.
12	(c) Any monies transferred from the community preservation trust fund to the

13 (c) Any monies transferred from the community preservation trust fund to the 14 neighborhood housing trust shall be used to encourage and facilitate the construction and 15 preservation of affordable housing pursuant to the rules and regulations adopted by the 16 neighborhood housing trust.
