*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 8,  
2 as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

4           Section 8. The northern red oak (*Quercus rubra*) shall be the tree or tree emblem of the
