An Act relative to fees for the use of State House facilities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 9A of chapter 8 of the General Laws, as amended by section 3 of the  
2 chapter 55 of the Acts of 2003, is hereby further amended by adding the following sentence: - No  
3 fee or charge shall be levied upon non-profit or advocacy entities and groups petitioning,  
4 informing or engaging elected or appointed officials of the Commonwealth for meetings,  
5 receptions or exhibitions held in the state house during business hours.
