The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to the annual observance of Massachusetts Women’s Defense Corps Remembrance Day.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section  
2 1500000 the following section:-

3 Section 15PPPPP. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart April  
4 2nd as the Massachusetts Women’s Defense Corps Remembrance Day, in recognition of the  
5 generous contributions of the approximately 18,000 women who volunteered to train as air raid  
6 wardens, drivers, communications personnel, canteen workers medics, chemical detections  
7 personnel and as emergency fire fighters, and recommending that the day be observed in an  
8 appropriate manner by the people.
