An Act to exempt senior citizens from BBRS licensing requirements.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 99 of chapter 143 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “inspectors”, in lines 6 through 7  
3 inclusive, the following words:- ; provided, however, that persons age 65 or older with 10 or  
4 more years of relevant experience, shall not be required to attend such meetings.
