An Act establishing School Bus Driver Day.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after Section  
2 15PPPPP, the following section:-

3           Section 15QQQQQ. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart  
4 October 20 as School Bus Drivers’ Day, in recognition of the invaluable contributions of the  
5 Commonwealth’s school bus drivers to the safe delivery of the state’s children to and from  
6 school, through all forms of climates and conditions, twice a day for 180 days a year, and shall  
7 recommend that the day be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
