Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 29 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby
2 amended by adding after Section 71 the following new section:-

3 Section 72. The Commonwealth shall not impose any parking fees upon state employees
4 at institutions of higher education.
