By Ms. Walz of Boston, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2904) of Martha M. Walz and Anthony W. Petruccelli for legislation to designate a certain pedestrian bridge located at Charles Circle in the city of Boston as the Frances “Fanny” Appleton bridge. State Administration and Regulatory Oversight.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act designating a certain pedestrian bridge in the city of Boston as the Frances “Fanny” Appleton Bridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The pedestrian bridge No. B16-438(BKF) located at Charles Circle spanning Storrow
2 Drive in the city of Boston shall be designated and known as the Frances “Fanny” Appleton
3 Bridge, in recognition of the celebrated courtship and marriage of Frances Appleton and her
4 husband, Henry Wadsworth Longfellow, after whom the adjacent bridge is named. The
5 Massachusetts department of conservation and recreation shall erect and maintain suitable
6 markers bearing the designation after consultation with The Esplanade Association and in
7 compliance with the standards of the department.
