An Act relative to renewable energy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (1) of Section 6 of Chapter 25A of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word
3 “emergencies;” in line 6, the following words:- provided however, in creating, developing and
4 administering programs related to renewable energy the Department shall not favor one
5 renewable technology over another.

6 SECTION 2. Subsection (8) of Section 6 of Chapter 25A of the General Laws, as
7 appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word
8 “responsibilities;” in line 25, the following words:- provided however, in promulgating rules and
9 regulations, and in approving or denying applications over which Department has such authority,
10 the Department shall not favor one renewable technology over another.
