**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**

An Act relative to junior operator’s licenses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1 Chapter 90 of the general laws is hereby amended by adding the following  
2 new section, Section 8AA.

3 SECTION 8AA Junior Operator’s License Violations

4 Any holder of a junior operator license convicted of the offense of the possession of  
5 alcohol, marijuana or of any other controlled substance deemed illegal by the commonwealth  
6 shall:

7 -forfeit his junior operator’s license

8 -be required to attend a substance abuse program for not less than three months

9 -pay a fine of not less than \$1,000 to the general fund of the commonwealth.

10 Such an individual shall not be eligible for another license to operate a motor vehicle  
11 from the commonwealth until the latter two requirements are fulfilled.

12 The registrar shall issue rules and regulations to carry out the above provisions.
