An Act to expand the move over law for utility vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1: Section 7 of Chapter 89 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “person,” in line 4, the  
3 following:-

4 vehicles owned and operated by a public utility or public service corporation or any under  
5 contract to a public utility or public service corporation and performing emergency service,

6 SECTION 2: Section 7A of Chapter 89, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting  
7 after the word “ambulance,” in line 2, the following:- public utility or public service corporation.

8 SECTION 3: Section 7C of Chapter 89, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting  
9 after the definition of “Person” the following definition:-

10 “Public Utility vehicle”, any vehicle owned and operated by a public utility or public  
11 service corporation or any under contract to a public utility or public service corporation and  
12 performing emergency service.

13 SECTION 4: Section 7C of Chapter 89, as so appearing, is here by amended by inserting  
14 after the phrase “highway maintenance vehicle”, in line 24, the following:- public utility vehicle.
