An Act authorizing translators for learner's permit tests.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 8B of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3           All non-English speaking applicants for a learner's permit shall be entitled to have a  
4 translator on the premises before such applicant takes such learner's permit test. The registrar  
5 shall place within all registry of motor vehicle locations signs stating that there are translators  
6 available in 48 different languages that and that such applicants may ask for assistance by a  
7 translator while taking such test.
