The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to livery vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 22 of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting before the first paragraph, the following:-

3 As used in this section, the following term shall, unless the context clearly requires
4 otherwise, have the following meaning:—

5 “Black Car”, any limousine or other vehicle which is designed to carry 15 or fewer
6 passengers, including the driver, and carries passengers for hire but is not available for pre-
7 arranged transportation. This definition shall also apply to cars that can only be scheduled using
8 an application on a cellular phone.

9 SECTION 2. Said section 22 of said chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby further
10 amended by inserting, in line 6, after the word “vehicles,” the following:- ,including black cars,.
