An Act entitling residents west of 128 to discounted access to the Massachusetts Turnpike.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 10 of chapter 354 of the Acts of 1952 is hereby amended by adding at the end  
2 thereof the following new sentence:— The Massachusetts Turnpike Authority is hereby directed  
3 to develop and institute a program providing discounted toll rates to residents who reside in  
4 communities that host any part of the Massachusetts Turnpike west of Route 128, and who  
5 participate in the E-ZPass MA program set forth by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, when  
6 they use the Massachusetts Turnpike. Such a discount shall be set at a rate which is not less than  
7 a ten percent discount off the maximum percentage toll provided by the Massachusetts Turnpike  
8 Authority to the residents of any other community in the Commonwealth.
