An Act relative to headstones for deceased members of the Massachusetts National Guard.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 115 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after  
2 section 9 the following section:-

3 SECTION 9A. The commission of veteran’s service shall furnish upon request  
4 headstones for deceased member of the Massachusetts National Guard who served 10 years or  
5 more. Such headstones shall be similar to those furnished by the U.S. Department of Veterans  
6 Affairs.
