## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to firearm safety training of military personnel.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

SECTION 1. Section 131P of chapter 140, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
inserting after sub-section (a) the following paragraph:-

3 Any current or former member of the United States military, who has not been prohibited

4 under section 129B of Chapter 140 to own a firearm, and has received adequate training while

5 serving in the military, shall be exempt from being required to submit a basic firearms safety

6 certificate to the licensing authority, upon submitting a copy of their most current military ID.
