An Act relative to automobiles.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1            Subsection (b) of section 7 of chapter 64I of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following 2 sentences:-

3            When seeking the familial exemption, the buyer and seller shall submit birth certificates  
4 to the registry in order to confirm the relationship. Any familial relation not listed shall not be  
5 eligible for the aforementioned tax exemption.
