### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to incumbent local exchange carriers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 159 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, 2 is hereby amended by inserting after Section 17 the following new section:-3 SECTION 17A. Every Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier Telecommunications 4 Company providing telecommunications service shall, using services located within the 5 commonwealth and their in-service area, provide call center service assistance for the following 6 services: 7 (1) Determining customer financial responsibility; 8 (2) Taking requests for new or additional services, requests for repair and 9 dispatching of troubles, including, but not limited to, Enhanced 911 emergency services; 10 (3) Determining deposit required, billing rate, or any other billing related 11 matters; 12 (4) Explaining company rates, regulations, policies, procedures, equipment, and 13 common practices; 14 (5) Investigating trouble order forms and initiating high bill investigations; 15 (6) Handling payment and other credit arrangements such as obtaining deposits, 16 financial statements, and payment plans; and 17 (7) Referring customers to social service agencies and other assistance programs.
