An Act relative to incumbent local exchange carriers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 159 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by inserting after Section 17 the following new section:-

3 SECTION 17A. Every Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier Telecommunications
4 Company providing telecommunications service shall, using services located within the
5 commonwealth and their in-service area, provide call center service assistance for the following
6 services:

- 7 (1) Determining customer financial responsibility;
- 8 (2) Taking requests for new or additional services, requests for repair and
9 dispatching of troubles, including, but not limited to, Enhanced 911 emergency services;
- 10 (3) Determining deposit required, billing rate, or any other billing related
11 matters;
- 12 (4) Explaining company rates, regulations, policies, procedures, equipment, and
13 common practices;
- 14 (5) Investigating trouble order forms and initiating high bill investigations;
- 15 (6) Handling payment and other credit arrangements such as obtaining deposits,
16 financial statements, and payment plans; and
- 17 (7) Referring customers to social service agencies and other assistance programs.
